

# **Wilderness Rendezvous RV Rules (WRRVP) Rules of Good Camping & Regulations**

Wilderness Rendezvous RV Park wants you and your family to have an enjoyable stay while at the RV Park. We have set the following policies, rules and regulations for our guests so that everyone will enjoy their stay.

## **Facilities**

- Common courtesy should prevail between all persons using the Park. Profane, abusive and/or threatening language or actions directed at Park personnel or other guests will not be tolerated. Anyone engaging in such an activity will be asked to leave the Park. Any guests whose actions interfere with the operation of the Park also will be required to leave.
- WRRVP reserve the right to ask anyone causing any disturbance to leave the premises.
- For the safety of all guests there is a maximum speed limit of 10 M.P.H. Road licensed motorcycles are permitted if operated in a quiet, non-disruptive manner. Park Management reserves the right to deny usage of any vehicle that is unsafe.
- No parking or driving on grass at any time is allowed for any reason.
- Smoking is not permitted in any park building.
- Guests are responsible for any damage to utility outlets or park property.
- Quiet time is between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. except for park pre-approved events.
- Signs and other notices cannot be posted in any areas without written authorization by the General Manager.
- No unauthorized soliciting or selling is allowed in the RV Park. No business is allowed to operate on or from the Park without prior permission from the General Manager.
- Guests use Wilderness Rendezvous RV Park facilities and amenities at their own risk. The Wilderness Rendezvous RV Park will not be responsible at any time for loss or damage due to theft, vandalism, fire, wind, weather, snow or freeze damage, catastrophic events, injury, accidents, or any other property or liability losses. Rv Campers are encouraged to purchase and maintain at their own expense RV Insurance.

## **Individual Sites**

- The privacy of others should be respected, please do not walk across others campsites.
- Units must have sleeping facilities, window coverings and approved electrical hookups (if used). We do not allow sleeping in cars, or outside of units. Electrical adapters at the pedestals are strictly prohibited.
- Sites are designated for a maximum of one (1) RV and one (1) tow vehicle. Extra vehicles, boats, trailers, etc. must be stored in designated parking areas for a fee, on a space available basis. Wilderness Rendezvous does not guarantee space for extra vehicles. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking spaces. Do not park on grass areas or hang over the ends of the pads. Do NOT park on vacant RV Spots.
- The Park reserves the right to remove RVs or vehicles from the Park at the owner's expense if the owner/operator abandons the vehicle; does not vacate when their period expires and/or violates any rule or regulation.
- No washing of vehicles or trailers is allowed in the park. You may have potted plants or flowers. Please keep them to a minimum.
- Please keep your own space, around and under your RV clean. Please keep items that are stored under and around the RV to a minimum and keep orderly. Clotheslines are not allowed.
- **NO VEHICLE FLUID CHANGES OR MECHANICAL REPAIRS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK!**
- Trash must be placed in the waste containers located throughout the Park. Our waste container can't accommodate large items and should be disposed of properly. Contact Management for locations that accept large items. Do NOT Dispose of Hazardous Waste; we are not an authorized recycling center, do not leave oil, batteries, paint or other hazardous materials at our dumpster, in or near our trash cans or anywhere else in the park. Please keep the Park clean by policing your site before departing.
- Wastewater must be discharged into authorized receptacles only and never discharged onto the ground. Sewer collars or approved positive sealed sewer connections are required at all times. Our Maintenance Staff verifies that all sites are in compliance.
- Open fires are not permitted at any time; charcoal or gas grills are acceptable.

## **Children**

- Wilderness Rendezvous guests are responsible for the conduct, behavior and control of their children and visiting guests. Also, Wilderness Rendezvous guests are financially responsible for malicious damage to Park property.

- Children under the age of 12 years must have adult supervision.
- Children and minors under the age of 18 years are required to be at their home campsite during "Quiet Time" hours.

## **Pets**

To insure all of our guests have a safe and enjoyable time and our neighbors do not have unwanted pets visiting their property, it is important that you read and abide by the following pet policy:

- We encourage all dog owners to call in advance to inquire about any specific rules that might apply to their situation. Please call in inquire about availability for you and your pet.
- Pets are one of our major concerns. Uncontrolled they detract from the enjoyment of the park by everyone. Quiet pets, under control and on a leash at all times are welcome. Please walk your pets in the designated area of park. Clean up "accidents" immediately. Please do not tie pets to trees or bushes or leave pets unattended around your vehicle or RV at any time. No pet pens, cages or kennels are permitted.
- RV fenced boundaries must be strictly adhered to. No Trespassing on adjacent lands is allowed.
- All dogs are required to be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. A 6' (six foot) leash rule is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owner's camping trailer, vehicle, or motor home. No dog should be left tied up and/or unattended outside the owner's camping equipment.
- Allowing your pet to bark uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted and you may be asked to leave if you are not able to control your pet's barking.
- Campers are responsible for their pet droppings.
- Aggressive dogs of any breed are not welcome at the Park. If your dog shows behavior that is protective and unfriendly to strangers, please do not bring it to the Park. If your dog exhibits this type of behavior the owner or management will ask you to find other camping accommodations.
- Service dogs of any breed are welcome. However, these animals must follow leash restraint policies and may not exhibit aggressive behavior.
- No pets are allowed in any building.
- A pet fee is required for each pet.
- Guests are responsible for all property damages and/or personal injuries resulting from their pet.
- Guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the RV Park, its owners and its operators from all liability and damage suffered as a result of the guest's pet.
- WRRR reserves the right to charge guest's account commensurate to the cost of such damages.
- Wildlife and domestic animals are prevalent and occasionally visit our campgrounds. We encourage our guests to enjoy them, but please do not bother them. We cannot be responsible for their natural behavior.

## **Amenities**

- By using the WiFi service you agree to be bound by the WiFi Service Agreement and abide by WRRR WiFi Policies.
- Showers: please leave the rooms as you would like to find them. We take pride in our cleanliness. If anything requires attention, let a park employee know.
- Animals are not allowed in the bathroom/shower facilities.

## **General**

- Park Management reserves the right to remove any guest from Park Property whose behavior adversely affects the use, enjoyment or safety of others.
- Absolutely no hunting is allowed on the premises or on the surrounding property.
- Willful damage or defacing of Park property will be cause for prosecution and immediate eviction.
- Metered electricity will be billed separately to your credit card on file. A deposit for electricity is expected at time of check in and regularly thereafter at kiosk is customers responsibility to ensure electricity is provided to your campsite. Customer takes full responsibility for maintaining their services and any and all potential damages that may occur to their property from the loss of heat and water to their property due to their failure to pay for these services in advance.
- Wilderness Rendezvous reserves the right to make changes to the Rules & Regulations at any time without prior notice.
- Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.
